CREATION CARE

April 22nd is EARTH DAY. This is a reminder that we can refocus on the importance of sustainability and being environmentally conscious.

Three tips for lessening our environmental impact are:

1. Gentle on the pedal--go easy on the gas and break pedals. Ease off to stop and coast to a stop and accelerate gradually when starting up from a stop. This will save gas and reduce wear and tear on tires. It saves money, too!!!

2. Driving at speeds above 60mph costs additional \$.24 per callon, according to the US Department of Energy.

3. Combine trips to reduce driving several days into one day of driving.
